

Simon Harrisson is a Research Director at the Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS), based in the Laboratory of Organic Polymer Chemistry (LCPO) in Bordeaux, France. He obtained a PhD from the University of New South Wales, Australia, in 2002. After postdoctoral fellowships at the University of Warwick and Washington University in St Louis, he joined the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation (CSIRO) in 2005. In 2010 he moved to France, working at the Institut Galénique at the Université de Paris-Sud and the Solvay Research & Innovation Center Paris, before joining the CNRS in 2014, initially at the IMRCP laboratory in Toulouse, before moving to the LCPO in 2019. Dr Harrisson has published over 90 peer-reviewed research papers and book chapters. His research seeks to apply a fundamental understanding of polymerization kinetics and mechanisms to the development of new materials.
