

Oliver Brüggemann studied chemistry at the University of Hannover, Germany (1988-1994). During his doctorate, he worked with the Institute of Food Research in Reading, UK, (1996) and with the EPF Lausanne, Switzerland (1996-1997). After receiving his doctoral degree at the University of Hannover in 1997, he continued his research as a postdoc at the EPFL, and in the following at Lund University, Sweden.
